SOLO SINGING: Rules and Regulations

- 1. Crescendo is an online music competition only for classes 8th to 12th students of St. Xavier's School, Raj Niwas Marg.
- 2. This will be an inter class competition
- 3. The time limit for the entire video is <u>**2mins.**</u> Exceeding the time limit will lead to deduction of points from the total score.
 - There are 2 categories -
 - English
 - Hindi
 - A contestant is allowed to participate only in 1 category.
 - The use of karaoke or backing tracks are not allowed. However, if

participants wish to play musical instruments, they're allowed to do so.

- 7. Participants will be judged on the following criteria-
 - Voice modulation
 - Rhythm & Melody
 - Dynamics
 - Please ensure that the video (indoor) has a decent lighting and audio quality. Kindly keep the Fan switched off during the recording to get clear audio.
- 9. The performance must be recorded in a single shot. Any kind of editing audio/video will lead to disqualification.
- 10. Participants should start the video by stating their Category (English/ Hindi), <u>name</u>,

class and name of the song. After this, they may immediately commence their

performance.

- **11.** The music video for the competition should be submitted at *xaviersmusicclub@gmail.com*
- **12.** The subject of the email must be in the following pattern: subject : Category(Hindi or English) Participant's name, class and section.
- 13. <u>Students are encouraged to compose their own songs. Self-composed songs will fetch</u> <u>extra marks.</u>

INSTRUMENTAL: Rules and Regulations

- 1. Crescendo is an online music competition only for classes 8th to 12th students of St. Xavier's School, Raj Niwas Marg.
- 2. The time limit for the entire video is <u>**2mins**</u>. Exceeding the time limit will lead to deduction of points from the total score.
- 3. Use of karaoke, Midi Tracks, Keyboard Rhythm, Pre-recorded beats is not

allowed. Keyboard can be used but without inbuilt preset rhythm.

- 4. Participants will be judged on the following criteria
 - a. Rhythm & Melody
 - b. Dynamics
- 5. Please ensure that the video (indoor) has a decent lighting and audio quality. Kindly keep the fan switched off during the recording to get clear audio.
- 6. For instrumental performance, both participant and instrument should be seen clearly.
- 7. The performance must be recorded in a single shot. Any kind of editing audio/video will lead to disqualification.
- 8. Participants should start the video by stating their category (Western/Indian)
